## Pinewood Derby Car Stands

Materials (makes at least 10 stands):

#6 x 1" wood screws

#6 x 1 1/2" wood screws

1" x 4" x 6' finish pine board

1 1/2" x 4' round dowel (Lowes didn't have pine, so this was poplar)

1/2" x 4" x 2' finish pine board (I bought 2 of these, but ended up only needing 1)

## Prep work before den meeting:

Base: Cut the 1" x 4" x 6' board into pieces that are about  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " long. Since the board is actually about 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide not 4" the finished base piece is 1" x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Using a  $\frac{7}{64}$ " drill bit, drill a hole in the center of the base.

Dowel: Cut into 2" lengths. Using a 7/64" drill bit, drill a hole through the center of the dowel piece.

Using a drill press, I had to drill from one end, then flip it over and drill from the other end.

Top: Cut the  $\frac{y_2}{2}$  x 4" x 2' board into pieces that are about 2" x 2  $\frac{y_2}{2}$ ". Using a 7/64" drill bit, drill a hole in the center of the top. Also cut pieces that are about 2" x  $\frac{y_2}{2}$ " x  $\frac{y_2}{2}$ ". Using wood glue, attach this piece to the front of the top piece.

## Boys do at den meeting:

Sand edges. Attach the base to the dowel using the 1½" screw. Attach the top to the dowel using the 1" screw. Since I didn't have enough screwdrivers to go around, I had half the den assemble first and half the den sand first. Paint.
